Tournament Regulations

1. ALL players must register to participate.
2. Tie Break: **1. Direct Encounter 2. Greater number of Victories 3. Buchholz 4. Buchholz Medium 5. Buchholz Cut 6. Sonneborn-Berger**
3. There will be no default time in round 1, however the Chief Arbiter may manually pair players after 10 minutes. Default time for rounds 2 to 5 will be 10 minutes.
4. Certificates will be handed out to players during their final round. Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 players for each section at Prize Giving.
5. **Appeal:** An appeal shall be submitted in writing to the CA or TD within 15 minutes after the completion of the specific round in question, accompanied by a fee of R200 {which will be returned if the appeal is successful}
6. The LOC reserves the right to waive criteria in all the sections or to cancel the event.
7. No spectators or parents will be allowed in the playing venues.
8. Once the players are done with a match, and their results have been recorded, they become "Spectators" and must leave the playing area immediately.
9. Photographs will be taken during the event and the award ceremony. All players are deemed to allow publication of photographs of them taken at the event by the organisers for publicity purposes unless they inform the organizers otherwise.
10. All FIDE Chess rules shall apply to the event
